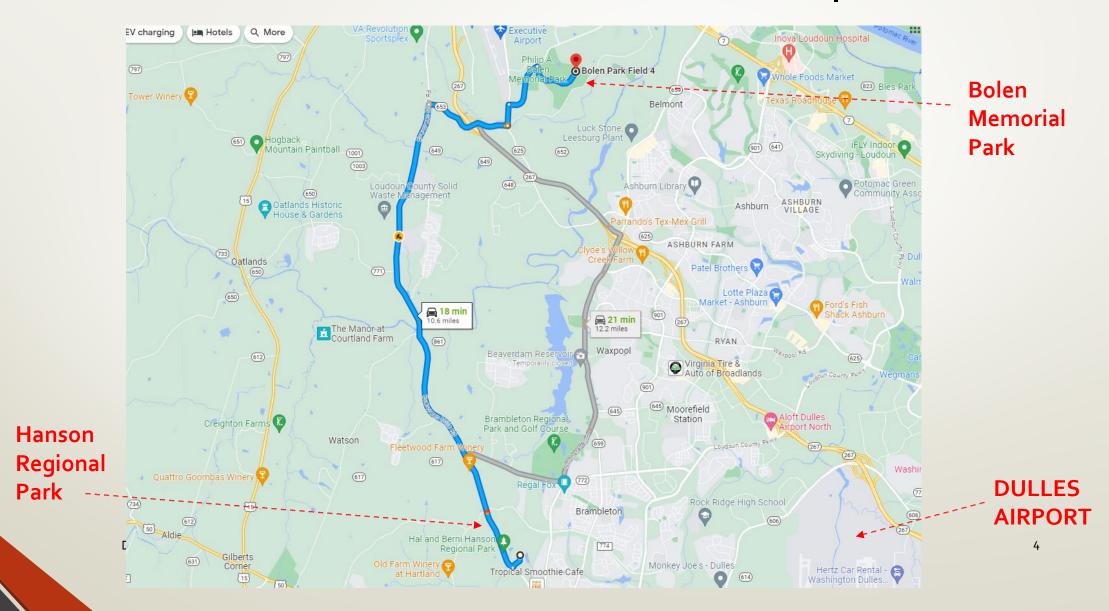

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# 2023 Tournament Points of Emphasis

- Tournament primary objective: SHOWCASE the best players in partnership with the best referees in competitive matches. Opportunity for players and referees to showcase their skills.
- RULES: <u>https://dcreferees.com/eastcoast</u>

- Match Reporting: Complete match report at fields and notify Copa Rayados personnel of misconduct (team/#/reason). Take picture of match report for future reference AND score reporting only in GameOfficials (using Notes)
- U11 25 min halves; no heading allowed
- U12 two 30 minute halves
- U13 / U14U -- two 35 minute halves
- U15 /U16/U17/U19 -- two 40 minute halves
- Each game will have a 5 minute halftime
- Stoppage time allowed for serious injuries.
- Substitutions for either team on any stoppage IF players are at midfield prior to stoppage OR in case of injury. Substitute Re-entry is allowed.
- Teams provide match balls, but have backup ball at midfield from either team.
- NO TEAM CHECK-IN AT FIELDS

## 2023 Tournament Points of Emphasis

#### **PROBLEM SOLVING:**

- Teams Not Matching in GameOfficials?
  - **REFEREETHE TEAMS WHO ARE AT THE FIELD but confirm age groups of the teams.**
- MISSING OFFICIALS?
  - TELL THE REFEREE SITE COORDINATOR or FIELD MARSHAL \*\*\*WHO\*\* IS MISSING so that absentee can be located or standby activated
- INJURED OFFICIAL
  - NOTE CHANGES IN CREW ASSIGNMENTS BY real-time reporting to site coordinator AND MANDATORY EMAIL to globalprisms@yahoo.com
- COVID SYMPTOMS
  - IMMEDIATE NOTIFICATION TO REFEREE SITE COORDINATOR AND MANDATORY EMAIL TO globalprisms@yahoo.com

### **Standby Officials**

#### • STANDBY OFFICIALS:

- SAT: Be on site from 8 AM to 12 PM OR 12 to 5 PM and report to Copa staff member or site coordinator.
- FRI: Be on site from 430 PM to 830 PM OR and report to Copa staff member or site coordinator.
- SUN: Be on site from 8 AM to 12 PM OR 12 to 5 PM and report to Copa staff member or site coordinator.
- Be in uniform and ready to step in in case of referee injury or traffic issue. We need to reach you via cell ph if you're not standing next to staff member so that you can be activated. If you are activated, document and email to <u>globalprisms@yahoo.com</u> after event so that you can be added to assignments for payout.

#### MENTOR PROCEDURES

- PASSCODE: will be emailed to mentors
- Feedback will be routed to each referee crew member via email within 14 days
- DEBRIEF AT FIELD MUST RESPECT TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE AS PRIORITY
- Encourage exchange of referee, mentor contact information AFTER matches have concluded but also available post-tournament
- Match Video: Referee May Ask but Team Prerogative

#### **Other Tidbits**

- PRINT SCHEDULES and FIELD ADDRESSES in Advance.
- FOOD: BRING FOOD AND WATER with you. LOTS OF WATER. LUNCH NOT PROVIDED.
- Weather: HOT. Wear layers of black clothing underneath jerseys as needed. SOLID BLACK HATS ALLOWED.
- Inclement Weather: NO CANCELLATIONS EXPECTED. IF issues, you will be notified by mails. DO NOT CONTACT USSF Assignor or Site Coordinator to ask. GO TO FIELDS unless notified by email.
- Photo Contest: \$25 reward to best three referee action photos from 2023 Copa Rayados Showcase Tournament. Judges include professional sports photographers and USSF Assignor Jesse Rosenthal Submissions to <u>wahooref@gmail.com</u> with name of photographer, field info, date/time of match. Referee family members are eligible for reward.
- HOTEL ASSIGNMENTS: Will be distributed after zoom with room confirmation numbers for out of town referees and mentors.

4) Watch another game with one of the mentors and discuss what each of you sees.

5) Stay after your matches and watch the crews to see if they are doing anything you can learn from.
